You can be part of Little Jems no matter what you believe; our teaching is clearly from the Bible but the children and their questions or opinions are always treated with respect and care. Parents are welcome to stay for the sessions. Little Jems is supported by Christ Church Pennington and CCP Primary School, and all the leaders have CRB clearance to work safely with children.

We start off the evening by having a game where we can run around to burn off some energy, then we have a craft time followed by drinks and a biscuit. We then have a story and finish again with a fun game.
